"EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULEBOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH."

Hunter sections may be run as back-to-back classes at management's discretion. When classes are run back-to-back, exhibitors may perform both rounds before leaving the ring.

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in and out, oxer, post and rails, gate, panels.

All classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted. Horses will not be jogged for soundness unless otherwise noted. Judges will reflect any unsoundness in their scores.

All Hunter Championships Classes: Awarded to the top two of the top four horses/ponies, which have earned the most points in over fences classes. In addition to these points, only these top four horses/ponies will receive full points for ribbons won in the under saddle class. In addition, Half points will be earned in the Regular Conformation Model class and the Green Conformation Model class, and the Small, Medium, Large & Green Pony Model classes.

Jumping Order: Jumping order will be established in accordance with the USEF rules.

In all classes over obstacles, all horses being considered for an award must jog for soundness using either Option A or Option B below. Management must state in the competition prize list which method of jogging will be used. Horses/ponies that are unsound will be eliminated and ineligible for an award in that class. The judge's decision regarding soundness is final.

Option A: Horses/ponies are required to trot a circle on a loose rein at the end of each over fences performance. Horses/ponies may be asked to return to the ring and trot another circle at the judge's discretion.

Option B: Horses/ponies will be jogged together with the rider unmounted in the judge's order of preference. Two additional entries in addition to the number of ribbons must jog if there are sufficient entries. Horses/ponies may be asked to re-jog at the judge's discretion. A horse/pony may not leave the ring until the job has been declared official by the judge, or it will be eliminated. A horse that is unruly, one that breaks away from the handler or one whose actions threaten to endanger the rider, handler, other exhibitors or their entries will be eliminated. (Exception: Hunter Breeding and Pony Breeding). A horse may not be eliminated for receiving outside assistance in the jog. In classes restricted to ponies a junior must jog the pony for soundness.

HU103 - All horses competing in Federation licensed and/or USHJA sanctioned competitions with Hunter, Hunter Breeding, Jumper and Hunter/Jumping Seat Equitation classes not restricted by breed must be properly identified in accordance with GR1101, and must also be registered with USHJA (see GR1101.1). The USEF/USHJA registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions.

Applications for USHJA Registration can be completed online at www.ushja.org or www.usef.org using the USEF Horse Registration application form. This form is also available from the USHJA or Federation office, as a download from the USHJA or Federation website or from competition management. Competition management is responsible for notifying exhibitors of this requirement in their prize list.

In addition to the provisions of HU 101.1, on or after December 1, 2017, all horses competing in classes that require USHJA horse registration must provide a microchip number that verifies their animal's identity in order to compete for points, money won or be eligible for Federation and/or USHJA programs and awards where horses are required to be recorded or registered.

A microchip used to verify identity must be a fifteen digit ISO compliant 11784/11785 chip and be implanted in the nuchal ligament of the animal.

Gimmicky options are not appropriate.

The Handy Hunter Round, consisting of a minimum of eight (8) fences with two (2) high options, shall be judged on quality, movement, jumping style, manners and way of going. Pace, brilliance, and a shorter track are to be rewarded. A horse/rider may not jump decorations or other obstacles in order to create a shorter track.

The Option Bonus Score of one (1) additional point for each higher height option fence jumped must be awarded even if there is a refusal, rail down or loss of good jumping style at that higher height option fence, providing that the horse- and rider combination does jump the higher height option fence. Twelve (12) entries are to return for the second round, then only the top twelve (12) horses from the first round, after all ties are broken, are eligible to return for the second round.

Tie Breaking Procedures

A. No panel may award the same base score to any two competitors in any one round unless a competitor's score is below the cut-off score.

B. Any ties in all rounds will be broken by the base score (before adding height bonus points) of that round.

C. Twelve (12) entries are to return for the second round, only the top twelve (12) horses from the first round, after all ties are broken, are eligible to return for the second round.

D. In the event of a ties for first place after the second round, the tied competitors will compete in a jump-off round. In the case of unsafe conditions preventing a jump-off from being held, the tie will be broken using the second round base score (before adding height bonus points).

E. Ties for other than first place in the overall standings will be broken using the second round base score (before adding height bonus points).

F. Prior to the start of the class, if two (2) judging panels are used, one (1) panel must be designated as the tie breaking panel for the first round and another panel must be designated as the tie breaking panel for the second round. The tie breaking panel for the first round will also be designated as the tie breaking panel for the jump-off round.

The flat phase will be judged on rider's position, seat, and correct effective use of aids. Riders will perform the working walk, the working trot sitting, and the working trot rising, as well as showing a lengthening of stride. Riders will also show the working canter, and the working canter showing a lengthening of stride. All riders will be required to show a working counter canter. No more than 12 riders shall counter canter at one time. In addition, the flat phase may include, but not limited to Shoulder-in, Shoulder-out, Haunches-in, and Haunches-out. The flat phase shall count for 40%.

Conditions: Only competitions recognized by the World Equestrian Center are eligible to hold the WEC Premier Equitation Cup Class. Only one rider per horse. Only one horse per rider. A minimum of two competitors are required to complete the course. If there are more than 25 entries at the beginning of the class, it may be divided by every other number and run as two separate sections. This class may not be run using a California split. Two refusals will constitute elimination.

In addition, riders are required to perform 2 of 3 basic dressage movements of a shoulder-in, haunches-in or leg yield both directions of the ring at the discretion of the judge. The Under Saddle performance of those riders selected to participate in this phase shall count 50% of the overall two phase performance. There is no minimum requirement to fill the class. Riders who do not return for the flat phase are not eligible for a ribbon overall per EQ107.6

Class to be judged in accordance with current USEF standards for equitation. Conventional tack per USEF EQ106.5. Splitting of classes: Classes with greater than 50 entries must be split using the California Split. No other method of splitting is allowed.

EMO INSURANCE USHJA 3'3" JUMPING SEAT MEDAL

USHJA 3'3" Jumping Seat Medal is open to Junior Active Members of the Federation and USHJA who have not reached their 18th birthday (per USEF rules). Any rider in his or her final Junior year may not compete in any classes held at a competition with a start date after August 1 of that competition year. Exception: riders in their final Junior year may compete in the USHJA 3'3" Jumping Seat Medal class held at the AON/USHJA National Championships. Riders must be current Active members of USEF and USHJA prior to the start of the class (see GR202). Foreign residents who are also members of USEF and USHJA will be eligible to compete.

A. The USHJA 3'3" Jumping Seat Medal is a two phase competition with the Jumping Phase to count as 70% and the Flat Phase to count as 30% and shall be judged on the rider's equitation style, technical merit, judgment and execution of an efficient, time saving pace and track.

B. Two cumulative refusals will incur elimination.

C. One (1) point will be subtracted from the rider's score for each commenced second over the time allowed and four (4) points will be deducted for each knockdown on course. JP137 (The competition round) and JP138 (Timing) will apply.

D. If as a result of a disobedience, a competitor displaces or knocks down any obstacle or in all cases where the nature of the obstacle is changed by a knock down, the tone is sounded and the time is stopped until the obstacle has been rebuilt. When the obstacle has been rebuilt, the tone is sounded to indicate that the course is ready and that the competitor can continue the round. The competitor is penalized for a refusal. The time is restarted at the moment when the horse leaves the ground at the obstacle where the refusal occurred. Judges are asked to walk the course when possible.

E. A minimum of three (3) riders and a maximum of twelve (12) riders (if available) will return for a flat phase. Riders to be judged on position, seat and the correctness and effectiveness of the aids. Excellence and effectiveness on the flat will be rewarded. The performance begins when the class is called to order. Riders will show in both directions as a group at the working walk, the working trot sitting, and the working trot rising, as well as showing a lengthening of stride; the working canter, and the working canter showing a lengthening of stride. All riders shall be required to show at the working canter on the counter lead in each direction. Judges may require any additional tests on the flat (see EQ113). In addition, basic dressage movements may be tested including but not limited to Shoulder-in, Shoulder-out, Haunches-in, and Haunches-out.

F. Riders must compete on the same horse for all phases; no horse substitutions allowed.eparate sections.

Course Requirements: A. The Jumping phase of the class shall be held prior to the Flat phase over a Jumper style course with a minimum of ten numbered fences at the respective height and spread.

B. Course must include a dry Liverpool.

1. Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE MODIFIED LEVEL OR ABOVE, COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, ENDURANCE RIDES AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS: (SEE GR828.4 OF THE FEDERATION RULES). LIFE, SENIOR ACTIVE AND JUNIOR ACTIVE MEMBERS SHALL BE ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL CLASSES AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS AT THE MODIFIED LEVEL OR ABOVE AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS AT THE ADVANCED LEVEL, DRESSAGE, REINING AND VAULTING COMPETITIONS AND ENDURANCE RIDES. A NON-MEMBER MAY PARTICIPATE AS A HANDLER, RIDER, DRIVER, OWNER, LESSEE, OR AGENT, AT REGULAR COMPETITIONS, EVENTING COMPETITIONS, DRESSAGE COMPETITIONS, REINING COMPETITIONS AND COMBINED DRIVING COMPETITIONS UPON PAYMENT OF A SHOW PASS FEE. PARTICIPANTS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES ARE EXEMPTED FROM THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS RULE: 1) LEADLINE; 2) EXHIBITIONS; 3) GAMES AND RACES; 4) CLASSES FOR 4-H MEMBERS; 5) WALK TROT (EXCEPTION: FRIESIAN PERFORMANCE FR231) AND ACADEMY CLASSES (ACADEMY CLASSES ARE CLASSES LIMITED TO HORSES USED REGULARLY IN A LESSON PROGRAM); 6) USDF INTRODUCTORY LEVEL TESTS, PAS DE DEUX AND QUADRILLE CLASSES; 7) NRHA ENDORSED REINING COMPETITIONS. 8) OPPORTUNITY CLASSES, 9) CITIZENS OF OTHER NATIONS WHO HAVE PROOF, IN ENGLISH, OF CURRENT MEMBERSHIP IN GOOD STANDING OF THEIR OWN NATIONAL FEDERATION, 10) USEA BEGINNER NOVICE DIVISION; AND 11) ASSISTANT HANDLERS IN DRESSAGE SPORT HORSE BREEDING CLASSES

SAFE SPORT STATEMENT: Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

FOX LEA FARM BIOSECURITY PROTOCOLS

Fox Lea Farm is dedicated to the health, welfare and safety of all exhibitors both equine and human. To protect our equine partners, we will be enforcing the following protocols:

- Provide a Statement of Health from your vet on veterinary letterhead that said horse has received regular and consistent vaccination against Equine Influenza and EHV 1 & 4 with most recent booster being within 180 days and not within 7 days. This will be in accordance with GR845.

In addition please follow these protocols:

- Not shown symptoms of or been treated for EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days
- Not been at a facility under quarantine for EHV-4/1 or exposed to any horses showing symptoms of EHV-4/1 within the past 28 days
- Any horse on the show grounds with a fever of unknown origin or of suspicious origin must be reported to Show Management and to the Show

Veterinarian. It is always better to err on the side of safety. Isolation stalls will either be available on the grounds or at a local veterinary practice if the need arises.

- Please take the time to review equine good hygiene practices. Please convey the importance of this to your equine caretakers for their daily routines.

3. Date of Entries: ENTRIES DUE: May 3, 2024. Post Entries will be accepted and all entries received at the horse show will receive a \$50 LATE FEE. It is recommended that entries be made **online at www.horshowsonline.com**. Fees will apply: Office Processing Fee \$65, Nightwatch \$22, applicable stabling fees, USEF & USHJA fees and others as noted on entry form. Email: horshowsonline.chja@aol.com. A 3% service fee will be charged to all credit card payments.

4. Acceptance of Entries: Once a horse is entered and accepted by the show it may not be withdrawn from competition without the permission of management. Exhibitors shall be held responsible for all fees of all horse entered by them or their authorized agents(s) even though payment of these fees is not submitted with the entry form. In any case, horses that have not shown in classes on which they have been entered shall forfeit their fees except if a horse becomes ill or is injured prior to the start of the class or classes entered. The entry fee in this case will be dropped, upon receipt of a certificate signed by a licensed veterinarian and presented to the show secretary prior to the start of the class or classes entered. Once the show has started, only certificates signed by the Show Veterinarian will be accepted.

The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any riders or exhibitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to cancel or combine any classes, or to reschedule classes after due notice to exhibitors; to change rings or rotate judges; use dotted line; and to change the specifications in jumper classes as competition warrants.

5. CFHJA MEMBERSHIP: Points will be recorded for Hunter, Jumper and Equitation classes entered by CFHJA members who are permanent residents of the state of Florida and for horses/ponies that are permanently stabled in the state of Florida. Permanent resident/horse/pony CFHJA members of the state of Florida will be eligible for CFHJA year end awards. Points will start accruing the date membership payment and membership form is received.
6. Required Signatures on Entry Form: Entry forms will be accepted only when signed by every exhibitor, rider, coach, agent, and trainer. If the rider or owner is a minor, the signature of the parent, guardian or trainer must be provided. Upon failure to sign an entry blank as required, such person (s) shall be subject to an automatic fine of \$250. (GR 908) Entry forms must be accompanied by a check for stall fee. No acknowledgement will be mailed.
7. Spectator admission per person is \$3.00 (including .20 sales taxes). All exhibitors, their families, trainers and grooms are exempt. Please pay at the show office. Maybe subject to COVID-19 sanctions.
8. STABLING: - The cost per boarding stall or tack boarding stall is \$275.00/ late \$300. Main Barn \$300/late \$325 after May 3, 2024. 254 Permanent boarding stalls with doors will be provided. Boarding Stalls are cement 12' by 12' with sand/clay flooring. Management reserves the right to limit tack boarding stalls. **STALL CHECKS MUST ACCOMPANY STALL RESERVATIONS.** Initial bedding will not be provided, and will be available through the Fox Lea Farm. Move in date is Wednesday early arrivals will be charged \$40.00/day. **All horses on grounds must wear their back number whether being hand walked or ridden at all times.**
9. Prize Money: Prize money will be credited back towards each exhibitor's account. All refunds will be paid within 30 days off the close off the competition. IRS 1099 Miscellaneous Income Forms will be issued to the 1099 designee listed on the entry form. **REFUNDS UNDER \$20 WILL BE CREDITED TO YOUR NEXT SHOW BILL.** Prize money will be paid within 30 days of the last day of the show.
10. Show Office Hours: The Show Office will be open beginning one hour before the start of each show day and will close one half hour after the last class. Exhibitor accounts will be processed and numbers given out in the show office on WEDNESDAY.
11. Back Numbers: Numbers will be issued only when entries have been paid or an open check has been left, and when all necessary signatures, addresses, Social Security Information for Prize Money, USEF measurement, amateur, and membership cards have been presented for all riders; trainers and owners on entry.
12. a) Presentation of Federation Membership Cards: All owners, senior, junior, amateur, adult amateur riders and trainers are required to be competitor members. Junior and pony hunters must present the actual or a copy of their measurement cards at the Show Office before numbers may be picked up. All ponies and junior hunters that do not possess a current measurement card will be measured. Time and place of measurement stations will be announced.
- b) USEF Eligibility/ USHJA Show Pass Fees:
USEF Non-member participants in the role of riders, drivers, handlers, vaulters, lungers, owners, lessees, and agents must pay a Show Pass fee. Competitions cannot accept payment for a Show Pass from exhibitors. Show Pass purchases can only be made online on the USEF website by exhibitors.
Non-member participants in the above roles are limited to obtaining no more than one (1) Show Pass per competition year.
To be eligible to participate at Federation Licensed Competitions, all persons acting as coaches or trainers, and legal guardians signing entry blanks as coaches or trainers on behalf of their minors must be Senior Active Members in good standing.
The eligibility requirement for foreign participants went into effect on September 1, 2023, and under this requirement, foreign participants are no longer permitted to participate in USEF national competitions by merely demonstrating good standing with their own National Federation. A few important notes on this:
Foreign Participants will now be required to join USEF as Competing Members.
Those individuals 18 years of age and older must take SafeSport Training to be eligible to participate in USEF national competitions.
For those participating in FEI events only, this requirement does not apply.
This requirement has been in effect since September 1, 2023, for all foreign competitors except Equestrian Canada competitors.
The online Show Pass form will be available on the USEF website and can be accessed at the following URL: <https://www.usef.org/show-pass> The Show Pass form cannot be completed until a competition start date is within the next 7 days or if the show is currently in progress.
13. Management reserves the right to limit the Courtesy Circle in Hunter and Equitation classes.
14. Horses competing without a number or with an incorrect number may be refused an award at Management's discretion.
15. Horses will be allowed in the show rings only at such hours as are announced by Management.
16. The Open Numerical Hunter Scoring System will be used at the discretion of Management.
17. Orders of Go are produced in accordance with USEF Rules. Riders and trainers who have conflicts due to classes in more than one ring at the same time should see the Paddock Master so that necessary adjustments can be made. At no time will any ring be held up over 3 minutes due to conflicts.

18. All dogs must be leashed at all times while on the show grounds. Loose dogs will be picked up and detained until the owner has paid a \$100 fine. For a second offense, the owner may be barred from showing and required to leave the show grounds. We find this extreme action necessary in order to protect our exhibitors and their horses from injury.

19. Parking will be permitted in designated parking areas only. Vehicles may be brought to the stabling areas for only the purpose of loading and unloading and then must be promptly moved to the Van Parking Area. Your cooperation is appreciated.

20. All entries are required to have a stall per show regulations.

21. In accordance with the 1989 Federal Waste Tracking Act, which restricts the disposal of medical waste, Bio Hazardous Medical Waste Containers will be provided in the stable area. All exhibitors and their agents are responsible for the proper disposal of the waste.

22. An office fee of 10% or \$25 (which ever is greater) will be charged on all returned checks.

23. All horses entering the state of Florida must possess an official interstate health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian attesting to the fact that the animals are free from any symptom of infections or communicable disease. Current negative Coggins Test must be available upon demand.

24. ADDS/ SCRATCHES: All adds and scratches must be completed through the Show Office **AND TAKEN TO THE RING BEFORE THE ADDED OR SCRATCHED CLASS BEGINS.**

25. Anyone mounted must wear ASTM/SEI approved helmets while on the show grounds. . See GR 801.2 for further details.

26. Central Florida Hunter Jumper Association, Inc., Fox Lea Farm, their officials and employees will not be responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to any exhibitor, spectators, guest, rider, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at any of the shows.

27. Should any question arise that is not provided for in the rules, the same shall be referred to the show committee whose decision shall be final.

28. Trophies: In classes not offering prize money, trophies will be awarded in the show office.

29. By signing the entry form, exhibitors acknowledge and understand the following warning as provided in Florida Senate Bill 1658, Chapter 773, "Equine Zero Liability Statute": **WARNING – Under Florida law, an Equine Activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risk of equine activities.**"

30. Tack stall splits will be accepted when all entries are received and before 3pm on Friday. If tack stalls are not split they will be billed to a barn account. All shavings and feed orders are COD by 6 PM on Friday.

31. **MOTORIZED VEHICLE USEF RULE –** Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

32. SCHOOLING RULES: WEDNESDAY SCHOOLING SCHEDULE OPEN SCHOOLING FROM 12 NOON TO 5PM.

33. CHECK OUT - ANY MISTAKES AT CHECKOUT MUST BE RESOLVED WITHIN 24 HOURS.

34. EXPRESS CHECK OUT FILL OUT A SELF-ADDRESSED ENVELOPE AND WE WILL SEND YOU YOUR STATEMENT.

35. Food concessions will be available during horse show hours.

36. All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Only one Registration Number will be issued per horse, and must remain with the horse throughout its career.

37. Equine Vaccination Rule GR845

At Federation licensed competitions, horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by

or under the direction of a veterinarian.

In the case of vaccines administered by a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide documentation from the veterinarian on documenting that the horse in question received the vaccinations; name of the vaccines and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of vaccines administered by a person other than a veterinarian, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a receipt of the vaccine purchase which is signed by the owner, or agent with care, custody, and control of the horse; name, serial number and expiration date of the vaccine; and date of vaccine administration.

In the case of a horse that is unable to receive either of the vaccinations due to a history of adverse reactions, the exhibitor, upon request by Competition Management, must provide a letter from the veterinarian on official letterhead stating that the horse in question cannot be vaccinated due to medical concerns and a log of temperatures taken twice daily for the seven days prior to entering the competition grounds. These horses must also have their temperature taken and logged twice daily while on the competition grounds. The log of temperatures should be provided to the Competition Management, steward, or technical delegate when requested.

Competition Management may not amend or enhance vaccination requirements without prior approval of the Veterinary Committee

In accordance with GR 1111.4: Contiguous states are: AR, KY, LA, MO, NC, VA

•JUDGING FOR ALL HUNTER SECTIONS:

- To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability to count.
- Horses and Ponies are not required to jog for soundness.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADULT AMATEURS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:

- To be ridden by exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year and who hold a current USEF Amateur certification.
- Open to horses and ponies.

ELIGIBILITY FOR CHILDREN'S SECTIONS: HUNTER, JUMPER AND EQUITATION:

- To be ridden by exhibitors who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER Sections offered and requirements:

- Adult Amateurs – may be split into three (3) sections Cross Entry:

Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class and any class where otherwise eligible. Riders who compete in the Amateur Owner Hunter and/or Jumper classes may show other horses that they own in the Adult Amateur Hunters. Riders competing in the Amateur Owner 3'3" section (but not competing in the Amateur Owner 3'6" section) may ride one horse that they do not own in the Adult Amateur Hunter section. Horses and ponies exhibiting in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Adult Amateur Hunter and any classes where eligible.

Horse and Rider Combination: No cross entry restrictions

Fence height: • 3'0" with spreads not to exceed the fence height. • Courses will not be adjusted for ponies. In and outs will be permitted.

Combining/Dividing Sections:

May be split into three sections: • Adult Amateurs 18– 35, • Adult Amateurs 36– 49, • Adult Amateurs 50 & over

The Adult Amateur Hunter section may be divided by age of rider and/or height of fences. If there are fewer than three (3) entries in a section, that section must be combined with another Adult Amateur section. The Adult Amateur Hunter section may be combined with the Children's Hunter section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. When sections are combined and there are more than 24 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: • Adult Amateur Hunter 18- 35, • Adult Amateur Hunter 36- 49, • Adult Amateur Hunter 50 & over

LOW ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER

Open to exhibitors who have reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

Cross Entry: Riders may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 3'3" (Exception: All Equitation classes). Riders who compete in the 3' Adult Hunters and/or the 3'3" Amateur Owner Hunter classes may show horses that they own in the Low Adult Hunters and one that they do not own in the Low Adult Hunters.

Horse and Rider Combination:

Low Adult Amateur Hunter horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes or section where fences exceed 2'9".

Fence height: • 2'6"

Combining/Dividing Sections: The Low Adult Amateur Hunter section may be combined with the Low Children's Hunter section when there are fewer than four (4) entries in either section. If sections are combined and there are more than 24 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section: • Low Adult Amateur Hunter

AMATEUR JUMPER Sections offered and requirements:

1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper • 1.10/1.15m Amateur Jumper

Competition Management may restrict cross entries between 1.10/1.15m and 1.00/1.05m sections at the same competition if stated in the prize list.

Rider: Riders competing in an Adult Amateur Jumper Classic may not compete in any other Jumper Classic above 1.15m, Welcome Stake, Mini Prix, or Grand Prix at 1.30m or above or in the highest prize money class of any 1.30m or above section at the same show.

Horse and Rider Combination: 1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same show.

1.00/1.05m Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one class, if both 1.00/1.05m and 1.10/1.15m are offered.

1.10/1.15m Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations are not permitted to cross enter into Amateur Owner Jumper classes or any class at 1.20m and above, that offers prize money, at the same competition. 1.10/1.15m Amateur Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one class, if both 1.00/1.05m and 1.10/1.15m are offered.

Horse/Pony No cross entry restrictions

Combining/Dividing Sections: Junior sections may be divided by or combined with Amateur Jumper sections, at management's discretion, if so stated in the prize list.

Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: • Low Adult Amateur Jumper • High Adult Amateur Jumper

EQUITATION

AGE GROUP EQUITATION: ADULT SECTION Sections Offered:

- Adult Equitation 18- 35
- Adult Equitation 36 & Over

Cross Entry: No cross entry restrictions.

Fence Height: • Minimum 2'9", maximum 3'3" - management must state height at which class will be offered.

- Management may offer multiple height options if stated in the prize list, but each course must be set at the same height throughout.
- Course design must comply with EQ108.11 except combination is optional.

• Spreads not to exceed fence height

Combining/Dividing Sections:

CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE Sections offered and requirements:

• Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under • Children's Hunter Horse 15- 17

Cross Entry: Rider: Riders in this section may enter any Equitation class and may compete one different horse in the Junior 3'3" Hunter section, but may not cross-enter into any Junior 3'6" Hunter or Junior Jumper class at the same show.

Horses/Ponies: Horses and ponies exhibiting in this section may cross enter multiple sections of Children's Hunter and any classes where eligible.

Horse and rider combination: No cross entry restrictions

Fence Height: • 3'0" with spreads not to exceed fence height. • In and outs will be permitted

Combining/Dividing Sections: The Children's Hunter Horse section may be divided by age of rider and/or height of fences. If the Children's Hunter Horse section is offered divided by age it will be divided: Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under and Children's Hunter Horse 15- 17. If there are fewer than three (3) entries in either age section, the two sections must be combined. The Children's Hunter Horse section may be combined with the Children's Hunter Pony, when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. Alternatively, the Children's Hunter Horse section may be combined with the Adult Amateur section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. The Children's Hunter (horse & pony) section may be combined with the Adult Amateur section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. When sections are combined and there are more than 24 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: • Children's Hunter Horse 14 & Under • Children's Hunter Horse 15- 17

LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE Eligibility:

Open to exhibitors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year.

Cross Entry: Rider: Riders may not cross enter into any class or section at the same competition where fences exceed 3'3" (Exception: All Equitation classes). Riders who compete in the 3' Children's Hunter Horse, Regular A Rated Pony Sections, and/or Junior Hunter 3'3" classes may show one horse in the Low Children's Hunter. Horse and Rider Combination: Low Children's Hunter horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes or section where fences exceed 2'9". Fence height:

• 2'6" Combining/Dividing Sections:

The Low Children's Hunter section may be combined with the Low Adult Amateur Hunter section when there are fewer than four (4) entries in either section. When sections are combined and there are more than 24 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section: • Low Children's Hunter Horse

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY

Sections offered and requirements: • Small/Medium Children's Pony • Large Children's Pony

Cross Entry: Rider: Rider age restrictions as found in Regular Pony sections do not apply. Riders may show only one pony in either the 2'0" or the 2'6" height of the Children's Hunter Pony section when also competing in the Regular Small, Medium or Large Pony and/or Green Pony Hunter sections. Riders cannot cross enter into any class where fences exceed 3'3" (exception: Riders may show in Pony Jumpers).

Horse/Pony: Ponies exhibiting in Children's Hunter Pony may cross enter into any class where otherwise eligible but the rider may not show the same pony in the regular pony section. Note: The pony may only be shown by one rider in the Children's Hunter Pony Classic and that rider must be declared prior to the first round of the Classic. Horse and Rider Combination: No cross entry restrictions

Fence Height: • Small/Medium Ponies: 2'0" with spreads not to exceed height of fence. • Large Ponies: 2'6" with spreads not to exceed height of fence. • Combinations will not be permitted.

Combining/Dividing Sections: The Children's Hunter Pony section may be divided by size. If the Children's Hunter Pony is offered divided by size it will be divided: Children's Hunter Pony Small/Medium and Children's Hunter Pony Large. If there are fewer than three (3) entries in either height section, the two sections must be combined. The Children's Hunter Pony section may be combined with Children's Hunter Horse when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. The Children's Hunter (horse & pony) section may be combined with the Adult Amateur section when there are fewer than three (3) entries in either section. When sections are combined and there are more than 24 total entries, the sections must be divided utilizing a Floating split, or a California split to create an even division of entries.

Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following sections: • Children's Hunter Pony-Small/Medium • Children's Hunter Pony-Large

LOW CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY

Eligibility: Open to exhibitors who have not yet reached their 18th birthday as of December 1 of the current competition year. Stallions are prohibited from all Low Children's Pony Hunter classes. Individual classes may be entered. (Exception: Under Saddle classes. See HU129.2).

Low Children's Hunter Ponies are not required to jog for soundness.

Cross Entry: Riders: Low Children's Hunter Pony Riders may not cross enter into any class with fence heights that exceed 2'9" or into the Children's Hunter Pony, Pony Hunter, or Green Pony Hunter Section at the same competition.

Pony: Ponies exhibiting in Low Children's Hunter Pony may cross enter into any class where otherwise eligible, but the Rider may not show the same pony in the Regular Small, Medium or Large Pony, Green Pony Hunter and/or Children's Hunter Pony sections. A pony may only be shown by one rider in the Low Children's Hunter Pony Division. In the Low Children's Hunter Pony Classic the Classic rider must be declared prior to the first round of the Classic.

Fence Height: • 2'0"

Combining/Dividing:

Combining: If there are fewer than three (3) ponies in the Low Children's Hunter Pony section, they may combine with the Low Children's Hunter Horse section. If there are still fewer than three (3) entries after the Low Children's Hunter Pony section has been combined with the Low Children's Hunter Horse section, these sections may only then combine with the Low Adult Amateur Hunter Horse section.

Dividing: Low Children's Hunter Pony may be divided if there are more than 20 entries in the Division

Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section: • Low Children's Hunter Pony

CHILDREN'S JUMPER

Sections offered and Requirements: • 1.00/1.05m Junior Jumper • 1.10/1.15m Junior Jumper

Cross Entry: Competition Management may restrict cross entries between 1.10/1.15m and 1.00/1.05m sections at the same competition if stated in the prize list.

Rider: Riders competing in a 1.0-105m Junior Jumper Classic may not compete in any other Jumper Classic above 1.15m, Welcome Stake, Mini Prix, or Grand Prix at 1.30m or above or in the highest prize money class of any 1.30m or above section at the same show.

Horse and Rider Combination: 1.00/1.05m Junior Jumper horse/rider combinations may not cross enter into any classes held above 1.15m at the same show. 1.00/1.05m Junior Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both 1.00/1.05m and 1.10/1.15m are offered.

1.10/1.15m Junior Jumper horse/rider combinations are not permitted to cross enter into Junior Jumper classes or any class at 1.20m and above that offers prize money, at the same competition. 1.10/1.15m Junior Jumper horse/rider combinations may enter only one classic, if both 1.00/1.05m and 1.10/1.15m are offered.

Amateur Jumper sections may be divided by or combined with Junior Jumper sections, at management's discretion, if so stated in the prize list.

Awards: Zone Horse of the Year Awards will be presented annually to the following section: • 1.00/1.05m Junior Jumper section • 1.10/1.15m Junior Jumper section

AGE GROUP EQUITATION: CHILDREN'S/JUNIOR SECTION Sections Offered: • Equitation 11 & Under • Equitation 12- 14 • Equitation 15- 17

Cross Entry: No cross entry restrictions.

Fence Height: • Equitation 11 & Under Minimum 2'0", maximum 2'6" - management must state height at which class will be offered. Management may offer multiple height options if stated in the prizelist, but each course must be set at the same height throughout. Course design must comply with EQ108.8 and 108.11, combinations not permitted.

• Equitation 12- 14 Minimum 2'9", maximum 3'3" - management must state height at which class will be offered. Management may offer multiple height options if stated in the prizelist, but each course must be set at the same height throughout. Course design must comply with EQ108.11 except combination is optional.

• Equitation 15- 17 Minimum 3'0", maximum 3'6" - management must state height at which class will be offered.

Management may offer multiple height options if stated in the prizelist, but each course must be set at the same height throughout. Course design must comply with EQ108.11 except combination is required. • Spreads not to exceed fence height

Combining/Dividing Sections:

2024 USEF Guidelines for Combining and Dividing Sections

Performance Hunter and High Performance Hunter.

a. Number to hold separate sections: Performance four (4) and High Performance three (3). If four (4) compete and only three (3) complete (i.e. one is eliminated or retires) points will be awarded as per GR 1113.

b. Combining

1. At all licensed competitions, if there are fewer than four entries in either the Performance Hunter 3'3" or Performance Hunter 3'6" they must be combined, but they cannot be combined with any other Hunter sections, except High Performance Hunter. If there are four or more entries in each Performance Hunter section, they must be held separately. If the Performance Hunter 3'6" and the Performance Hunter 3'3" sections have fewer than three entries after they have been combined they may be further combined with the High Performance Hunter section.

2. If there are fewer than three entries in the High Performance Hunter section it must first be combined with the Performance Hunter 3'6" section or the Green Hunter 3'9" section (or with Green Hunter 3'6"/3'9" if offered combined). If the High Performance Hunter section is combined with the Performance Hunter 3'6" section it may then further be combined with the Performance Hunter 3'3" section, but may not be combined with the Green Hunter section(s).

3. When the High Performance Hunter section is combined with the Performance Hunter section the following applies:

a. When combining High Performance Hunter with Performance Hunters, the combined sections must offer the same number of classes offered by the Performance Hunter section(s) with which it is combined.

b. When combining High Performance Hunter with another section, if different amounts of prize money or entry fees were offered in the original sections, the combined sections will use the lower amount for both prize money and entry fees.

4. When the High Performance Hunter section is combined with the Green Hunter section the following applies:

a. If, after combining, there are still fewer than three entries in the combined section, it must be further combined with the Green Hunter 3'6" section

b. If combined Green Hunter sections have fewer than three entries, they must be combined with High Performance Working Hunter.

c. A horse that is eligible for more than one section must be declared and compete in only one. Horses will jump the respective height for the entered section.

d. When combining High Performance Working Hunter with another section, if different amounts of prize money or entry fees were offered in the original sections, the combined sections will use the lower amount for both prize money and entry fees.

e. When combining a section of High Performance Hunter with either a section of Green Hunter 3'6", Green Hunter 3'9", or both, the combined sections must offer the same number of classes offered by the Green Hunter section(s) with which it is combined. In addition, a section entry fee will be required and individual classes may no longer be entered for the combined section.

f. The High Performance Hunter section may be combined with a combined Green Hunter 3'6"/3'9" section but may not be combined with any Green Hunter 3'3" or 3'0 sections.

c. Dividing:

1. In Performance Hunter, High Performance Hunter and any other sections where individual classes may be entered, the sections may only be divided after thirty (30) horses have competed in the first over fences class. Subsequent classes may be divided once twelve (12) horses have competed in each class. For Championships, see HU154.

Green Hunter

a. Number to hold separate sections: three (3).

b. Combining:

1. Green Hunter section(s) may not be combined with any other hunter section(s). (Exception; The High Performance Hunter section may be combined with the Green Hunter 3'6" and 3'9" sections, see HU164.1)

2. Regardless of competition rating, each Green Hunter section that is offered separately must be held separately when there is a minimum of three entries.

3. If there are fewer than three entries in a Green Hunter section, that section must be combined with a contiguous fence height section of the Green Hunter.

4. If, after combining, there are still fewer than three (3) entries in the combined section, it must be further combined with the next contiguous fence height section of the Green Hunter.

5. In the case where there are no entries in the fence height section that bridges the gap between the two non-contiguous fence height sections those two non-contiguous fence height sections may be combined.

6. If Premier or National rated Green Hunter 3'0" and/or 3'3" sections are combined with Premier or National rated Green Hunter 3'6" and/or Green Hunter 3'9" sections a Handy Hunter class is not required. The combined sections must meet class number requirements for Premier or National rated Green Hunter 3'6" and

Green Hunter 3'9" and use the lower amount for both prize money and entry fees.

7. When the High Performance Hunter section is combined with the Green Hunter section the following applies:

a. If, after combining, there are still fewer than three entries in the combined section, it must be further combined with the Green Hunter 3'6" section

b. If combined Green Hunter sections have fewer than three entries, they must be combined with High Performance Working Hunter.

c. A horse that is eligible for more than one section must be declared and compete in only one. Horses will jump the respective height for the entered section.

d. When combining High Performance Working Hunter with another section, if different amounts of prize money or entry fees were offered in the original sections, the combined sections will use the lower amount for both prize money and entry fees.

e. When combining a section of High Performance Hunter with either a section of Green Hunter 3'6", Green Hunter 3'9", or both, the combined sections must offer the same number of classes offered by the Green Hunter section(s) with which it is combined. In addition, a section entry fee will be required and individual classes may no longer be entered for the combined section.

f. The High Performance Hunter section may be combined with a combined Green Hunter 3'6"/3'9" section but may not be combined with any Green Hunter 3'3" or 3'0 sections.

c. Dividing:

1. Regardless of competition rating, any Green Hunter section that is offered combined must be split by fence height, and sections held separately when there is a minimum of three entries in any one fence height section provided at least three (3) entries remain in each of the other two sections, which would also be held separately, or as one other combined section. Contiguous fence height sections should be combined before combining non-contiguous fence height sections.

Young Hunter

a. Number to hold separate sections: three (3). b. Combining:

1. Young Hunter section(s) may not be combined with any other Hunter section.

2. At Competition Management's discretion, and with at least three (3) Young Hunters entered in any section, the Young Hunter Section(s) may run concurrently with the corresponding Green Hunter height section or Combined Green Hunter Section. Horses that are entered in both the Young Hunter and Green Hunter section(s) will be eligible for awards in both sections. Horses that are not entered in both sections will only be eligible for awards in the section in which they are entered. If there are fewer than three (3) entries in any of the Young Hunter section(s) they must be combined for awards per HU166.3. A separate entry fee for the Young Hunter Section will apply. The Green Hunter section requirements by rating listed in HU166.2 will still apply.

3. Regardless of competition rating, each Young Hunter section that is offered separately must be held separately when there is a minimum of three entries. If there are fewer than three (3) entries in a Young Hunter section that section must be combined with a contiguous fence height section of the Young Hunter. If, after combining, there are still fewer than three (3) entries in the combined section, it must be further combined with the next contiguous fence height section of the Young Hunter. In the case where there are no entries in the fence height section that bridges the gap between the two non-contiguous fence height sections those two non-contiguous fence height sections may be combined.

c. Dividing:

1. Regardless of competition rating, any Young Hunter section that is offered as a combined section must be split by fence height, and sections held separately when there is a minimum of three entries in any one fence height section provided at least three (3) entries remain in each of the other two sections, which would also be held separately, or one other combined section. Contiguous fence height sections should be combined before combining non-contiguous fence height sections.

Green Conformation Hunter 3'6" and High Performance Conformation Hunter a. Number to hold separate sections: three (3).

b. Combining:

1. The Green Conformation Hunter 3'6" may only be combined with the High Performance Conformation Hunter. The High Performance Conformation Hunter may only be combined with the Green Conformation Hunter 3'6".

2. When offered as two sections, if there are fewer than three (3) horses in either the Green Conformation 3'6" or the High Performance Conformation section they must be combined.

3. When combining Green Conformation Hunter with High Performance Conformation Hunter, if different amounts of prize money or entry fees were offered in the original sections, the combined section will use the lower amount for both prize money and entry fees.

c. Dividing: If there are three (3) or more horses in each Conformation section they must be held separately.

Junior Hunter

a. Number to hold separate sections: four (4) in each section. If four (4) compete and only three (3) complete (i.e. one is eliminated or retires) points will be awarded as per GR 1113.

b. Combining:

1. The Junior Hunter 3'6", Junior Hunter 3'3", Amateur Owner Hunter 3'6", and Amateur Owner Hunter 3'3" sections may only be combined with other Junior Hunter or Amateur Owner Hunter sections.

See below for conditions.

2. At Premier, National or Regional rated competitions if there are fewer than three (3) entries in the Amateur Owner 3'3", the Amateur Owner 3'6", the Junior Hunter 3'3" or the Junior Hunter 3'6" sections, Competition Management may choose to combine the sections. The Competition Management may choose to combine the sections as necessary, based on the sections with the lightest entries. If sections are combined, the horses must jump the respective height of the original section entered. In addition, while the sections can be combined if entries warrant, in order for Horse of the Year points to count they must be offered separately in the prize list for Premier rated competitions (see HU122). When sections are combined as per above, three (3) must complete for points to count.

3. It is recommended that when competitions anticipate 50 horses or more this section be divided by age of rider or height of horse when prize list is prepared.

c. Dividing:

1. When divided, sections must be split using one of the methods from HU161 Methods of Dividing.

2. If there are 50 or more entries in the section at the beginning of the first class it must be divided and the prize money must be doubled.

3. If there are 50 or more entries remaining in a section after it has been divided, the section must be redivided and the prize money must be doubled. Once a section has been redivided it may be divided further if management so desires.

4. If the Junior Hunter sections are divided by height of animal, they must be divided into Large and Small. Premier rated Junior Hunter 3'6" sections at Premier rated competitions must be offered as four sections (large/younger, large/older, small/younger, small/older).

5. If there are four (4) or more entries in each divided section, the divided sections must be held separately. If there are fewer than four (4) entries in any sections divided by age and/or height of animal, those sections must be combined with other sections. If there is a minimum of twelve (12) entries once any sections have been combined, the newly combined section must be redivided.

Amateur Owner Hunter

a. Number to hold separate sections: four (4) in each section. If four (4) compete and only three (3) complete (i.e. one is eliminated or retires) points will be awarded as per GR 1113.

b. Combining:

1. The Amateur Owner Hunter 3'6", Amateur Owner Hunter 3'3", Junior Hunter 3'6", and Junior Hunter

3'3" sections may only be combined with other Amateur Owner Hunter or Junior Hunter sections.

See below for conditions.

2. At Premier, National or Regional rated competitions if there are fewer than three (3) entries in the Amateur Owner 3'3", the Amateur Owner 3'6", the Junior Hunter 3'3" or the Junior Hunter 3'6" sections, competition management may choose to combine the sections. The competition management may choose to combine the sections as necessary, based on the sections with the lightest entries. If sections are combined, the horses must jump the respective height of the original section entered. In addition, while the sections can be combined if entries warrant, in order for Horse of the Year points to count they must be offered separately in the prize list for Premier rated competitions (see HU121). When sections are combined as per above, three (3) must complete for points to count.

3. At Premier, National or Regional rated competitions if there are fewer than three (3) entries in the Amateur Owner 3'3", the Amateur Owner 3'6", the Junior Hunter 3'3" or the Junior Hunter 3'6" sections, these sections may be combined. The competition management may choose to combine the classes as necessary, based on the sections with the lightest entries. If sections are combined, the horses must jump the respective height of the original section entered.

c. Dividing:

1. Amateur Owner 3'6" When a section is divided, one section must be offered for amateurs 18-35 and one section for amateurs over 35 years of age. If there are four (4) or more entries in each divided section, the divided sections must be held separately. If there are fewer than four (4) entries in either divided section, they must be combined. If there are a minimum of 12 entries once the sections are combined, the newly combined section must be redivided using either a Floating or California Split. (See HU162 & HU160 for definition of a Floating and California Split.) When using a floating split the age groups must be posted at the competition office. Rider age must be given on the entry blank.

When divided as to age of rider no horse may compete in more than one section. These sections may be further divided by age of rider or by every other number.

2. Amateur Owner 3'3" When a section is divided, one section must be offered for amateurs 18-35 and one section for amateurs over 35 years of age. If there are four (4) or more entries in each divided section, the divided sections must be held separately. If there are fewer than four (4) entries in either divided section, they must be combined. If there are a minimum of 12 entries once the sections are combined, the newly combined section must be re-divided using either a Floating or California Split. (See HU164 & HU162 for definition of a Floating and California Split.) When using a floating split the age groups must be posted at the competition office. Rider age must be given on entry blank. When divided as to age of rider no horse may compete in more than one section. These sections may be further divided by age of rider or by every other number.

Pony Hunter

a. Number to hold separate sections: three (3). b. Combining:

1. The Regular Pony Hunter Section may not be combined with any other sections.

2. Height sections may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) in any height section. Combined

height sections should be either small/medium or medium/large but if possible not small/large. c. Dividing:

1. Classes for Pony Hunters may be divided by height of pony as outlined in HU141.

2. If there are 50 or more entries in the division at the beginning of the first class, it must be divided by height of pony and prize money must be doubled.

3. If there are 50 entries remaining in a section after the section has been divided by height of pony, the section must be re-divided by every other number and the prize money must be doubled.

4. Once a section has been re-divided it may not be divided further.

5. If a pony under saddle class has over 30 entries, the class must be split and held in at least two sections with one set of awards.

6. If there are a minimum of 10 small/medium ponies combined and 10 large ponies in any Regional rated Regular or Green height Section, the height section must be divided (small/medium and large); if there is a total of thirty (30) ponies, prize money must be doubled.

Green Pony Hunter

a. Number to hold separate sections: three (3) per section. b. Combining:

1. The Green Pony Hunter Section may not be combined with any other sections.

2. Green Pony Hunter Sections at National and Premier rated competitions may be combined if there are fewer than three (3) entries in any height section. c. Dividing:

1. National and Premier rated competitions must split (small, medium and large) if there are four (4) or more entries in any height section.

2. If there are a minimum of 10 small/medium ponies combined and 10 large ponies in any Regional rated Regular or Green height section, the height section must be divided (small/medium and large); prize money need not be doubled. If there is a total of thirty (30) ponies, prize money must be doubled.

Adult Amateur Hunter

a. Competitions must offer Adult Amateur Hunter sections in accordance with the specifications of each USHJA Zone.

b. Notice of the use of a floating split and the age groups must be posted at the competition office. When divided as to age of rider no horse may compete in more than one section. Age must be given on entry blank. These sections may be further divided by age of rider or by every other number.

Children's Hunter

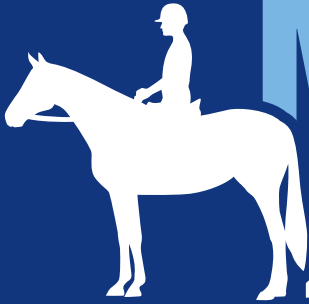
a. Children's Hunter sections must be combined or divided in accordance with applicable Zone Specifications

a. Low Adult Hunter sections must be combined or divided in accordance with applicable Zone Specifications.

Low Children's Hunter

a. Low Children's Hunter sections must be combined or divided in accordance with applicable Zone Specifications.
